# **HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS**



#### Step One Businesses Sign-Up

Eligible businesses sign-up, are approved, and then select a website template to submit the information they want to see on their online store.

#### Step Two Set-Up Support

Each business is assigned to a student who walks them through the process of developing their online store.

#### Step Three Online Store Development

Once all the details are collected, the student constructs the online store. When completed, the online store is sent to the business for review, requested changes are implemented, and the store is then ready for launch.

## Step Four Launching Online Store

With a new online store in hand, each business receives onboarding support from their assigned student to get their store launched. This includes adding inventory, setting up payment options, educating on shipping, lessons in digital marketing, and tips and tricks to get the most out of their online store.



### Step Five **Ongoing Support**

After the site is launched, participating businesses can book follow-up time with their assigned student to help them deal with any issues or improvements they would like to pursue.











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
