

BY-LAW NO. 7-90
TOWN OF VEGREVILLE

This By-Law being By-Law No. 7-90 of the Town of Vegreville in the Province of Alberta to Control Noise within the Corporate Limits of the Town of Vegreville.

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Section 160(1)(g) of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of prohibiting, eliminating, or abating noise and;

WHEREAS, the Town of Vegreville deems it proper and expedient to restrict and abate such activities, which gives rise to undue, and unnecessary noise and;

WHEREAS, it is the intent of this By-Law to control noise which disturbs the comfort or repose of other persons in the vicinity of such property or generally within the limits of the Town of Vegreville.

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Town of Vegreville in the Province of Alberta duly assembled enacts as follows:

1. The By-Law shall be cited as the Town of Vegreville Noise Control By-Law.
2. No person shall make, cause, continue to cause, or allow to be made any loud, unnecessary or unusual noise which either annoys, disturbs, injures, endangers or detracts from the comfort, repose, health, peace or safety of other persons within the Corporate boundaries of the Town of Vegreville.
3. No person shall allow property belonging to him or under his control to be used so that there occurs thereon or emanates therefrom any loud, unnecessary or unusual noise which either annoys, disturbs, injures, endangers or detracts from the comfort, repose, health, peace or safety of other persons within the Corporate boundaries of the Town of Vegreville.
4. Town Council or the Administrator may authorize a special permit for permissible noise levels for varying periods of the day; in all or a designated part or location of the municipality.
5. Any person who contravenes any provision of this By-Law or suffers or permits any act or thing to be done in contravention or in violation of any of the provisions of this By-Law is guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine of not less than \$200.00 (Two Hundred Dollars) and not more than \$500.00 (Five Hundred Dollars) or to imprisonment for a term of not more than 6 (six) months.

This By-Law to take effect on the final reading thereof.
