

**Cardboard** (remove liners & flatten boxes to save room) **NO GARBAGE**®

- ✓ Boxboard/Paperboard (cereal, beer, pop, kleenex, shoe boxes, etc.)
- ✓ Corrugated cardboard (boxes with a ruffled or grooved pattern inside)
- ✓ Furniture, Appliance, boxes etc.
- ✓ Paper towel tubes
- ✓ Toilet paper tubes
- ✓ Brown paper bags
- ✓ Brown packing paper
- ✓ Clean paper plates
- ✓ Egg cartons (cardboard only)




**Ineligible/Unacceptable Cardboard Recycling Materials**

- X Wet cardboard
- X Wax lined cardboard
- X Cereal, whipping cream, milk cartons, pop and juice containers are refundable at the Bottle Depot
- X Visibly contaminated boxes (food traces inside)
- X Construction materials like sawdust, wood, floor dry, scrap metal, shingles, insulation, drywall
- X Pet litter/floor dry
- X Diapers
- X Ashes

**Newsprint** **NO GARBAGE**®

- ✓ Newspapers/Flyers/Junk Mail/Journals
- ✓ Magazines/Catalogues (Sear's, Canadian Tire, Chatelaine, etc.)
- ✓ Brown envelopes (with or without plastic windows)
- ✓ Paperback books/Hard cover books/Telephone books
- ✓ File folders/Duo tangs
- ✓ Colored paper
- ✓ Stickers
- ✓ Construction paper
- ✓ Tan packing paper
- ✓ Calendars/Posters
- ✓ Gift wrap paper
- ✓ Pictures



**Ineligible/Unacceptable Newsprint Materials**

- X Contaminated/stained papers
- X Wet paper
- X Napkins
- X Paper towels
- X Carbon paper
- X Sanitary products
- X Kleenex tissue
- X Fabric softener sheets
- X Shop/hand towels
- X Diapers
- X Insulation/Drywall

## White Office Paper

NO GARBAGE®

- ✓ Office paper
- ✓ Writing/lined paper
- ✓ Notebook paper
- ✓ Legal paper
- ✓ Fax paper
- ✓ White packing paper
- ✓ White Envelopes (with or without plastic windows)
- ✓ White Shredded paper (bagged please) *loose shredded paper will intermix and blow away when the bin is emptied*



## Ineligible/Unacceptable White Office Paper Materials

- X Contaminated/stained papers
- X Wet paper
- X Wax paper
- X Carbon paper
- X Napkins
- X Kleenex tissue
- X Paper towels/shop hand towels
- X Sanitary products
- X Fabric softener sheets

## Solid Plastics (# 1-#7)

NO GARBAGE®



All Plastic containers with a #1 to #7 on the bottom/lightly rinsed please  
Some examples of these food and non food solid plastics are:

- ✓ Shampoo, conditioner bottles
- ✓ Margarine tubs
- ✓ Laundry soap and fabric softener containers
- ✓ Liquid soap containers
- ✓ Salad dressing containers
- ✓ Kitty litter containers, etc
- ✓ Vinegar jugs
- ✓ Plastic milk jugs, juice and dairy bottles are refundable at the Bottle Depot
- ✓ With lids & labels



## Ineligible/Unacceptable #1-#7 Plastic Materials

- X Plastic containers with no number or triangle on the bottom
- X Pesticide containers – there is a recycling cell at the Sanitary Landfill for those
- X Tupperware
- X Some plastic toys (look for the symbols)
- X Some types of clothes hangers (look for the symbols)
- X Styrofoam
- X Garden hoses/PVC tubing
- X Toilet seats
- X House siding
- X Window blinds
- X Toothpaste tubes
- X Christmas lights
- X Extension cords

## **Film Plastics (Soft Plastics)** **NO GARBAGE®**

- ✓ Most translucent soft plastic bags or light film plastic (*stuff bags into one bag and close*)
- ✓ Shopping bags/ Grocery bags
- ✓ Sandwich baggies
- ✓ Ziploc baggies
- ✓ Dry cleaning plastic
- ✓ Saran/stretch wrap
- ✓ Bread bags



### **Ineligible/Unacceptable Film Plastic Materials**

- X Black garbage bags
- X Green garbage bags
- X Orange garbage bags
- X Tarps
- X Shower curtains
- X Baler twine
- X Tie straps
- X Vinyl films

## **Tin/Aluminum Cans** **NO GARBAGE®**

- ✓ All food/non food tin or aluminum cans
- ✓ Tin foil
- ✓ Metal pie plates/trays
- ✓ Empty non-hazardous aerosol cans
- ✓ With lids & labels
- ✓ Lightly rinsed



**Note:** Placing garbage in with recycling materials will contaminate the product. Ensure bin lids are closed at all times to keep rain and snow out. (cardboard, newsprint and white papers are deemed non recyclable once soiled)



The VMRF will confidentially shred any documents or papers you would like destroyed due to confidentiality reasons or identity theft. For a minimal fee we will shred your documents. It's an affordable and effective way to protect your personal information.



The Town of Vegreville also offers its residents and surrounding area residents more opportunities to further recycle products. The Vegreville Sanitary Landfill has designated areas for other recyclable items like: electronic waste (computers & TV's), paint, non-rechargeable batteries, metals, tires, wood, compost, concrete and pesticide containers.

**Note:** There are drop off boxes at the VMRF office for old cell phones, ink/toner cartridges and rechargeable batteries.

**Note:** For staff safety reasons we will not be able to accept glass in the Residential Blue Bins. Bins for glass are available at the Central Drop-Off Centre (4822-51 Ave) and the Materials Recovery Facility (5201-52 Ave) Metal lids from glass containers can be placed with the tin/aluminum cans.
