

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF VEGREVILLE TO AUTHORIZE THE RATES OF TAXATION TO BE LEVIED AGAINST ASSESSABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE TOWN OF VEGREVILLE FOR THE 2013 TAXATION YEAR.

WHEREAS The Town of Vegreville has prepared and adopted detailed estimates of the

municipal revenues and expenditures as required, at the Council meeting held on

March 25, 2013; and

WHEREAS The estimated municipal expenditures and transfers set out in the budget for the

Town of Vegreville for 2013 total \$25,565,134 and

WHEREAS The estimated municipal revenues and transfers from all sources other than taxation

is estimated at \$17,387,134, and the balance of \$8,178,000 is to be raised by general

municipal taxation; and

WHEREAS The requisitions are:

Alberta School Foundation Fund (ASFF)

Residential/Farmland \$1,079,764 Non-Residential \$755,446

Machinery & Equipment (M&E)

Elk Island Catholic Separate Regional Division No. 41

WHEREAS The Council of the Town of Vegreville is required each year to levy on the assessed

value of all property, tax rates sufficient to meet the estimated expenditures and the

requisitions; and

WHEREAS The Council is authorized to classify assessed property, and to establish different

rates of taxation in respect to each class of property, subject to the Municipal

Government Act, Chapter M26, Revised Statutes of Alberta, 2000; and

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WHEREAS The assessed value of all property in the Town of Vegreville as shown on the assessment roll for municipal purposes is:
