

Safety First: Bicycle Helmet Reminder from **Vegreville Enforcement Services**

Vegreville Enforcement Services would like to take a moment to remind our community about the important safety regulations regarding bicycle helmets. In Alberta, it is mandatory for everyone under the age of 18 to wear an approved bicycle helmet while riding.

Key Facts About Helmet Safety

- Age Requirement: All cyclists under 18 must wear an approved bicycle helmet.
- Trail-a-Bikes & Trailers: Children being carried on trail-a-bikes or in trailers must also be equipped with an approved helmet.
- Proper Fit: Ensure the helmet sits approximately an inch above your eyebrows and is level on your head. The straps should form a "V" shape just below your ears. To verify that the helmet is secure but not too tight, place two fingers between your chin and the strap.
- Power Bicycles: Riders of power bicycles have the option to wear a bicycle helmet instead of a motorcycle helmet
