## CARDBOARD

- Flattened (liners removed)
- Corrugated/Paperboard (large & small)
- Paper towel/toilet paper tubes
- Cardboard egg cartons
- Colored cardboard
- Cereal/Pop/Beer boxes
- Paper bags



## NEWSPRINT

- Newspaper/Flyers/Junk Mail
- Catalogues/Magazines/Telephone Books/Cards/Postcards
- Tan Packing paper/Gift wrap paper
- Pictures/Calendars/Posters
- All Books (hard cover & paper back)
- File Folders/Brown Envelopes (with plastic windows)

## GLASS

- All non-refundable glass
- Glass jars/drinking glasses, etc.
- Free of food, metals, plastics and wood
- Clean/rinsed with lids removed



## SOLID PLASTICS

- Clean/rinsed food containers, margarine tubs, sour cream/yogurt/ketchup, etc.
- Clean/rinsed non-food containers, laundry soap/shampoo containers/CD, DVD cases/ice cream pails, etc.
- Lids included



## FILM PLASTICS

- Translucent soft plastic bags or light film plastics
- Shopping bags/bread bags
- Food/non-food bags/baggies
- Plastic wrapping/Dry cleaning bags/Ziplocs/ sandwich baggies

## WHITE PAPER

- Office paper/writing paper
- Notebook paper/legal paper
- White shredded paper (bagged)
- White envelopes (with plastic windows)

The Materials Recovery Facility will securely shred your confidential/personal documents for a minimal fee. Call 780-632-3197 for more information

## TIN/ALUMINUMS

- Clean/rinsed non-refundable food/non-food tin or aluminums
- Tin foil, aluminum pie plates, cans, cookie sheets, cookie tins, etc.
- Labels removed



## CANNOT ACCEPT IN BINS

- Wet/soiled recyclables that contain food, liquid or contaminants
- Tissues/napkins/paper towels/fabric softener sheets
- Sanitary products/Diapers
- Styrofoam
- Tarps/shower curtains/garden hoses
- Orange/green/black garbage bags
- House siding/Vinyl
- Clothing
- Wax-lined cardboard

**Note: Placing garbage in with recycling will contaminate the entire bin. Ensure lids are closed at all times to keep rain and snow out. (Wet cardboard, newsprint, and white paper is deemed non-recyclable once soiled)**
