jugs, tubs



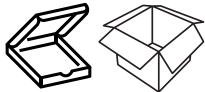
Single-use

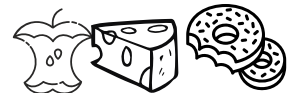


Go bagless and leave it on your lawn or
top up your food scraps cart

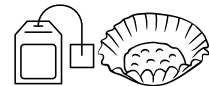
Scraps and peelings

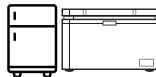
